

PARIS MAIN ATTRACTIONS TOUR



Discover Paris' main attractions in just three and a half hours: this introductory walking tour is perfect for first-time visitors to the city.

Departing directly from your hotel, you'll explore Paris with our experienced local guide. You'll head to the Trocadero for an up-close view of the Eiffel Tower.

Next, you'll see the Arc de Triomphe and stroll along the Champs-Élysées. Then, admire the Place de la Concorde, the beautiful Tuileries Gardens, and the Louvre Pyramid.

MONTMARTRE TOURS

SECRET MONTMARTRE TOUR







Discover the steep streets of the pretty Butte Montmartre and a wall of "Je t'aime" (I love you), a church with eclectic architecture, urban art, passages with staircases and old lampposts, film locations, a breathtaking view of Paris but far from the tourists, a small square dear to Picasso, surviving mills, vineyards, a culde-sac with charming houses from the 1920s, and many more Montmartre surprises - let yourself be guided!

SACRE-CŒUR ET UPPER MONTMARTRE







Discover the secrets of the Sacré-Coeur Basilica, its astonishing architecture all its hidden symbols.

In addition, your guide will introduce you to the surroundings of the Sacré-Coeur, Saint-Pierre de Montmartre church, the famous Place du Tertre with its painters and portraitists, Montmartre vineyards and the cabaret du lapin agile, the oldest Cabaret in Paris.

Audiophones can be hired for this tour, as silence is mandatory in the Basilica. Your guide will whisper into his transmitter, and you'll hear his explanations directly in your ear.

MONTMARTRE IN THE MOVIES

Montmartre is one of the most filmed Parisian neighborhoods in the world!

The film tour will take you to the locations where films (John Wix 4, ...) and TV series (Emily in Paris,...) have been shot in Montmartre, and will provide you with plenty of anecdotes about the filmmakers and the shoots.

The tour will include photos and video clips of the filming locations.

Let's walk in the footsteps of the famous painters who lived in Montmartre: Renoir, Toulouse Lautrec, Van Gogh, Picasso, Utrillo and many others...

Find out where they lived and what influence their Montmartre years had on their painting and their careers!

Follow the Impressionists, Cubists and Fauvists as they take us on a colorful journey!

Your guide will introduce you to a selection of surprisingly diverse street artists in Montmartre!

On this original, 100% street-art tour of Montmartre, let your guide, a specialist in urban art, lead the way.

CULTURE, ART AND WINE IN MONTMARTRE MONTMARTRE TOUR AND TASTING EXPERIENCE



Discover a guided tour covering the winegrowing history of the Butte Montmartre, the importance of the winegrowing tradition even today with the fête des vendanges, and ending with a unique French wine-tasting experience either at a Montmartre wine shop, hosting a painting exhibition, or at a Montmartre art gallery, hosting a sommelier to comment on the French wines tasted - an unforgettable experience!

The wine tasting will be accompanied by a delicious board of French cheese and charcuterie

Another option is to combine another Montmartre tour theme (secret Montmartre, Upper Montmartre and Sacré-Cœur, painters or street-art) with a French wine tasting.

Duration: 2 hours (tours) + 1,5 hours (wine-tasting)








ILE DE LA CITE TOUR



Discover the birthplace of Paris, a fascinating place steeped in history.



Your history-loving guide will introduce you to Notre-Dame-de-Paris cathedral, a iewel of Gothic architecture, the Sainte-Chapelle and Conciergerie, the secret of Henri IV's statue on the Pont Neuf, as well as the tragic fates of the Templars and the Cursed Kings, and legendary lovers Heloise and Abelard...



An unforgettable historical tour!

« LE MARAIS » DISTRICT WALKING TOUR

On this must-see tour, we'll discover Paris's finest remnant of a medieval city wall, a jewel of medieval and Renaissance architecture, a Baroque church, a Gothic church, the oldest organ in Paris, a secret passageway to the oldest square in Paris, Victor Hugo's house, sumptuous mansions such as the Hôtel de Sully, medieval houses and even a medieval wine cellar.

This tour is packed with fascinating historical anecdotes.

THE LATIN QUARTER TOUR

Discover the timeless charm of the Latin Quarter, where your passionate guide will take you on a journey through two thousand years of history, from the Lutetia arenas, the ancient remains of Paris, to the Pantheon, the necropolis of famous men and women.

The churches of the Latin Quarter are true architectural treasures, such as Saint-Etienne-du-Mont with its magnificent rood screen and the church of Saint-Séverin, a flamboyant Gothic masterpiece. Duration: 2 hours







TOUR OF SAINT-GERMAIN-DES-PRES



This is a beautiful Parisian neighborhood, with its

abbey palace, the mighty Abbey of Saint-Germain, iconic cafés such as Café de Flore and Les Deux Magots, the pretty Place Fürstenberg and the Eugène Delacroix Museum.

Your tour of the district begins at **Saint-**







Your guide will show you many curiosities, including the **astonishing sculpture** "La Poésie", an allegorical work by Pablo Picasso in homage to the poet Guillaume Apollinaire.

You'll discover the historical, artistic and cultural aspects of this mythical neighborhood, so intellectual, **so Parisian** - an essential visit!.

THE BUTTE-AUX-CAILLES DISTRICT TOUR



Follow your guide through the picturesque little streets of the Butte-aux-Cailles in the 13th arrondissement and be amazed by its working-class and revolutionary past, atypical housing developments such as "petite Alsace" and "petite Russie", the houses of the Cité Daviel, a hidden hot-air balloon and its amazing history.







NEW ATHENS DISTRICT TOUR

Let us guide you through a romantic Paris, with its Hôtels Particuliers, secret gardens, artists' studios and old theaters.

Your guide will bring to life some of the neighborhood's most colorful characters, great names in painting and literature such as Victor Hugo, George Sand and Alexandre Dumas, and even in music such as Frédéric Chopin.

Duration: 2 hours



THE PARISIAN COVERED PASSAGES



First invented in Paris in the 19th century, covered passages are so beautiful that they have been copied in other cities in France and abroad.

A special place to rediscover, a source of inspiration for film sets, a landmark for collectors of old books, your guide will reveal many of their secrets through anecdotes.

For example, one of the passages was a place of intrigue for François Vidocq, pioneer of the Parisian



criminal police, while another was known to the musician Chopin..

VENDOME – OPERA GARNIER – RIGHT BANK



Place Vendôme

Starting with the Tuileries Garden, the quintessential French garden from the reign of the Sun King, Louis XIV, this tour emphasizes the grandeur of Paris. It delves into the transformations made by Napoleon and his nephew Napoleon III, who thoroughly revamped the city. You will find yourself at the heart of Parisian luxury, discovering its stunning architecture.

Highlights: Concorde Square, Tuileries garden, Place Vendôme, Opéra Garnier, Square Edouard VII, Coco Chanel's workshop, La Madeleine church, rue Royale.





LE LOUVRE MUSEUM

Did you know that the Louvre boasts no fewer than 480,000 works of art?



Follow our experienced guide on a tour of the world's most prestigious museum, and discover the great masterpieces of the Louvre (the Mona Lisa, the winged Victory of Samothrace, the Venus de Milo, Liberty guiding the people by Delacroix, the raft of the Medusa by Géricault, the Coronation of Napoleon, treasure of the italian Renaissance...). Duration: 2 hours









THE ORSAY MUSEUM



The Musée d'Orsay opened in 1986 and is housed in the former Orsay railway station, completed in 1900. Its collections present Western art from 1848 to 1914, in all its diversity: painting, sculpture, architecture and more. It is one of Europe's leading museums for this period.

This private tour will reveal to you the secrets of a unique selection of impressionnist masterpieces from the Musée d'Orsay. Duration : 2 hours

THE GIANT MURAL FRESQUES TOUR



Discover giant frescoes by leading international muralists, created at the request of the 13th arrondissement town hall. We present emblematic works by renowned contemporary artists such as Obey, C215, Pakone and Jorge Rodriguez-Gerada.

Your guide will introduce you to the works and techniques used, and the socio-political context of these creations

STREET-ART TOUR OF BUTTE-AUX-CAILLES



Located in the south of Paris, the Butte-aux-Cailles is known for its rich street-art scene, an exciting universe of varied artists. the Butte-aux-Cailles is a veritable breeding ground for experienced urban artists, recognized nationally and even internationally (Seth, Jef Aerosol, Miss Tic, Tito Mulk, etc.).

We'll learn about techniques such as graffiti, stenciling and collage.. Duration: 2 hours

TOUR OF THE PERE LACHAISE CEMETERY





Discover Paris's largest and most prestigious cemetery, opened in 1804 and now containing over 70,000 tombs. Duration of the tour: 2 hours

Your guide will bring to life the great writers (Balzac, La Fontaine, Molière, Proust ...), painters (Delacroix, Géricault ...), musicians (Chopin, ...), politicians (Adolphe Thiers, Jean Casimir-Perier, ...) and show you the Mur des Fédérés in memory of the Commune.

This will be an opportunity to rediscover these great celebrities, and to listen to your guide's anecdotes, which will revive their memories..







FLEA MARKET TOUR



Les Puces de Saint Ouen is Paris' largest flea market and said to be the largest antiques market in the world, with more than 2,000 shops and stalls. Discover the legendary market with our local guide, receive insider tips and advice on where to find the most unique pieces, and shop for traditional handicrafts, prized antiques, and vintage fashions. Pick up insider tips and advice from a Parisian.
